- Infantile colic (IC) is a common condition. However, there is a lack of guidelines regarding its management approach.
- Based on study data from 4000 online questionnaires, it was demonstrated that simethicone reduced crying and discomfort-associated behaviour, and improved the baby's sleeping patterns.
 - More than two-thirds (69.7%) of respondents, who either used the suspension on its own or alongside another treatment, reported improvements in signs of IC within one day.
 - Almost all (93.2%) considered its use associated with either complete resolution of IC or had some effect on symptoms.

Simethicone offers symptomatic relief in IC, including reducing crying and discomfort, and improving sleep patterns.
