Statins Protect against Venous Thromboembolism

- A review of 36 clinical studies on statins have demonstrated that statin users had a 15%-25% lower risk of venous thromboembolism (VTE) than non-users.
- The observations suggest a role for statins in the primary prevention of VTE.
